Attention!

PMD bags are only meant to be used for small domestic packaging waste!



Food and garden waste



All peels and remains of eggs, nuts, vegetables, fruits and potatoes (raw or prepared)



Garden clippings, cut grass, leaves and plants



All remains of meat and fish, (fish)bones (raw or prepared)



Tea bags and coffee filters with contents and all other food waste (pasta, rice, bread, cheese, et cetera)



Small pets waste (rabbits, hamsters, guinea-pigs) including straw, biodegradable catlitter, including waste

Collected every week!

Attention!

- ◆ Dispose all food waste using the green bin!
- ◆ In winter months the green bin is collected every two weeks



Diapers and incontinence materials

Take diapers and incontinence materials to a collection point for recycling in your district.

Dumpsters are placed in streets below:

Separating household waste for recycling, a joint effort!



Textile containers, thrift shop and recycling station

Textile containers

Take waste clothing and shoes to a textile container, belonging to 'Pastoor Vekemansfonds'. Visit www.pastoorvekemansfonds.nl for a container in your district.

Thrift shop

Take discarded but still reusable goods (clothing, furniture, household goods) to thrift shop 'Kringloop De Kempen'. At request, goods are picked up at your home address. Visit www.kringloopdekempen.nl for more information.

Recycling station 'Milieustraat'

Individuals can take all waste that is not collected door-to-door to recycling station 'Milieustraat' (rubble, building and construction waste, white and brown goods). Maximum overall amount of sorted waste is 2 cubic meters. Proof of identity is necessary.

Household hazardous waste (KCA)

Household hazardous waste translates in Dutch as 'Klein Chemisch Afval' (KCA). This includes:



Batteries, insecticides, mercury-containing products



Insecticides, spray cans



Thinner, turpentine, aerosols with content, paint waste and paint remover



Medicines

Every district is visited by the 'Chemo car' twice a year. You can take your KCA there. Visiting dates and locations are available at www.veldhoven.nl/afvalkalender. You can take KCA also to the recycling station 'Milieustraat' (free of charge).

Waste paper and cardboard



Printer and writing paper, envelopes, leaflets, newspapers and magazines

Visit www.veldhoven.nl/afvalkalender and enter your postal code and house number for collection dates. You can print or save an annual overview of collection dates. It is also possible to add the dates as iCal-file to your digital diary.



Waste glass

Take empty bottles and jars (no window glass, pyrex glass) to a collection point for recycling glass ('glasbak') in your district. Dumpsters are placed in streets below:
